SPECIAL INFORMATION

It is the desire of the Youth Camping Program for all campers to attend the *entire camp*. If you are unable to attend the *entire camp* according to the start and end dates, you must make arrangements prior to the start of the camp with the director.

Visitor Policy – We have a no-visitors policy at our youth camps. If it is necessary for anyone to make a visit, prior arrangements must be made with the director and be limited to the designated area. Each camper should bring bedding materials, clothes, bath towels, shampoo, soap and etc. to live at the campground for the specified number of days of the camp.

Swimsuit policy – Please, bring appropriate swimming attire consistent with a church sponsored activity.

Snacks – Campers are not allowed to bring food or snacks to camp. Any such items will be confiscated and given back at the end of the camp.

Shoes – All Campers should bring lace-up tennis shoes as some activities at camp require them.
