

FOUNDRY HILL CAMPGROUND PET POLICY AND GUIDELINES

Our Campground is pet friendly and welcomes campers who enjoy traveling and sharing their camping experience with their pet(s). Please be advised that the pet owner assumes complete liability for their animal while on the premises, including damage to property. For everyone's enjoyment, including pets, please observe the following pet camping rules. Failure to abide by these rules may result in the camper being asked to board the pet outside the park or check out of the campground.

- Pet(s) are limited to “private” RV, camper or tent guests only. Pets are not allowed to stay in campground provided facilities (e.g. camper, tents, cabins) nor brought to common areas such as dining hall, bath houses, Tabernacle, campfires or other areas frequented by campground campers.
- Maximum of 2 pets per RV site.
- All pet(s) must be on a leash not to exceed 6’ and under the control and visual observation of their owner at all times when not confined in privately provided facilities.
- Pet(s) may not be left outside, unattended. No ropes or leashes are to be tied to trees or shrubs.
- Pet(s) must not be walked by children under 13 years old.
- Your pet(s) must keep quiet at all times and must not bother neighboring campers.
- Non-furbearing pet(s), such as reptiles, birds or fish, must be confined or under the physical control of the owner. Captive wild species, whether native or non-native and barnyard animals are prohibited.
- All pet owners are required to pick up all pet droppings on and off their site, seal droppings in a plastic bag and disposed of in a trash receptacle.
- All pet(s) must have proof of vaccinations to be presented to the campground staff when requested. [rabies and distemper]
- Guests of campers are not permitted to bring pets(s).
- We reserve the right to refuse entry to any pet(s).
- Pet(s) must always be well-behaved.
- If your pet(s) is not following these rules, is creating a disturbance (barking, destructing property, etc.), and/or displays viscous or aggressive behavior, you will be asked to

remove the pet(s) from the premises. If the owner will not comply, the camping party will be required to leave.

Foundry Hill Campground welcomes service animals. As defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) “a service animal is any dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks that benefit an individual with a disability.” Animals with other specialized training will be classified as pet(s) unless given special permission by the event director and Foundry Hill Campground Board.

Our pet policy applies to visitors with service animals with the following exceptions/additions:

- Working service animals are allowed in all areas of the campground when accompanied by their handler; except for the food prep area in the dining hall.
- If special permission is granted by the camp director and Foundry Hill Campground Board for the individual and service animal to stay in other quarters, besides an RV site, the service animal must be housebroken and crated if left unattended by the handler. Crate is to be furnished by the handler. Foundry Hill Campground Board reserves the right to periodically inspect the quarters where the animal is staying to ensure policy compliance.
- Service dogs must be harnessed, leashed, or tethered, unless these devices interfere with the service animals’ work or the individual’s disability prevents using these devices.
- We recognize that service animals are not always working. When the service animal is not working or with their handler all points of the pet policy apply.
